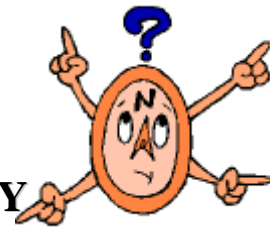


FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND THE MAIN LIBRARY
